



11-3-2021 UPDATE from the Library Director

Since our last update, COVID-19 cases in Washtenaw County have risen and fallen with no real consistency, but the county remains at a HIGH level of community transmission. Therefore, masks are still required for anyone aged two (2) and older to enter the library building.

Local, state, and federal guidelines recommend vaccination and masking to contain the spread of COVID-19 and prevent further outbreaks. See [WHEN TO WEAR A FACE MASK](#) from MDHHS.

The Saline District Library Board has adopted a [COVID Prevention Policy](#) intended to protect the health and safety of its employees and visitors to the Library. This policy details the guidelines established for masking requirements inside the building that are based on stated recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control.

- During periods of **substantial or high** COVID-19 transmission rates in Washtenaw County, face masks are **required** for anyone aged two (2) and older to enter the library building.
- During periods of **low or moderate** COVID-19 transmission rates in Washtenaw County, face masks are recommended.

Washtenaw County is currently at the High level of community transmission. Therefore, all staff and visitors are required to wear face masks at the Library.

Compliance with this policy will allow us to maintain services and help keep everyone safe. We appreciate your understanding and assistance.
